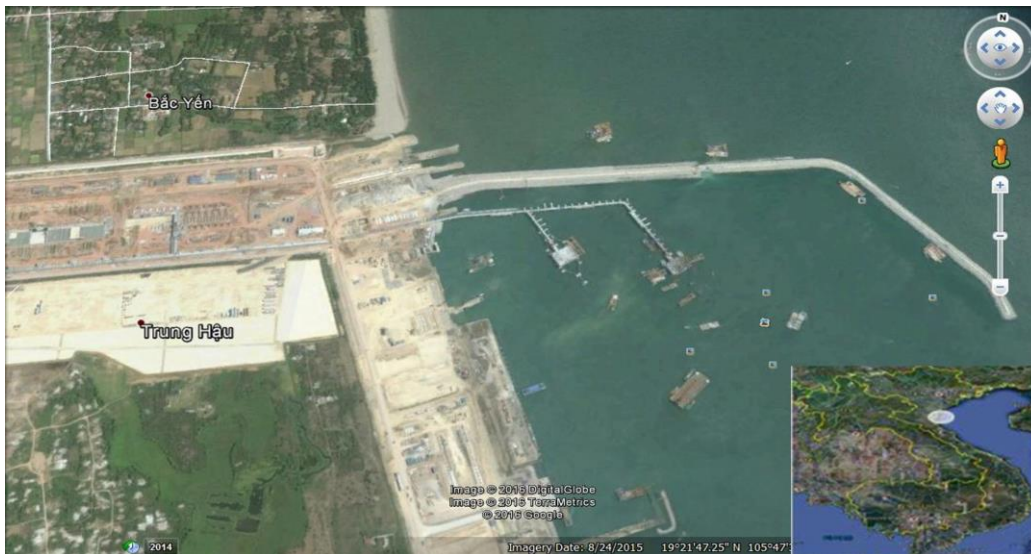

Geometra International (Private) Ltd. was awarded “NSRP Project/Barge Positioning Survey & Touchdown Monitoring Survey & Post Construction Survey in Vietnam”.

The owner of the project was SK Construction and the contractor was JGCS Consortium, a joint venture made between JGC, Chiyoda, GS, SK & Technip and the vendor was Hyundai Heavy Industries Co. Ltd. The contracted value of the project was USD 4,300,000.

NSRP Project is a joint-venture project sponsored by 4 corporations: Vietnam Oil and Gas Group (PetroVietnam), Kuwait Petroleum Europe B.V. (KPE) from Kuwait, Idemitsu Kosan Co., Ltd and Mitsui Chemical, Inc. from Japan. The Project, a mega refinery and petrochemical complex, is devoted to the energy security of Vietnam, particularly the security of petroleum products.



As per the project specifications, Geometra’s scope of work included Mobilisation i.e. installation and calibration of Inspection class ROV, Positioning and Navigation equipment onboard HD 2500 Pipelay barge; Performing Touchdown monitoring and Positioning & Navigation survey services for 48” twin pipelines running up to 68.925 km in total; Subsea Positioning Services for installing PLEM, Spools and FOC Mattress; 7.5 km of onshore pipe pulling activities at work site; Mobilisation of DP 1 Vessel and provision of Multibeam survey services with complete post construction survey of pipelines North and South (34.5 kms each) along with installing ROV and CP system for As-built inspection survey.
